2022/152 Declarations of Interest and requests for dispensation – No interests were

declared & there were no requests for dispensation.

2022/153 Minutes of Parish Council Meeting – The minutes from the Meeting of the Parish

Council on 21st March 2023 were considered, approved & signed as a true record

2022/154 County & District Cllr Penny Otton – Cllr Otton's report to the Parish Council had

been received & was noted. Cllr Otton reported that work was to be done on vegetation clearing at The Orchard to alleviate visibility & parking difficulties and undertook to monitor the outcome. She also confirmed that she was retiring from Mid Suffolk District Council after thirty-two years' service. It was also noted that Cllrs Simpson

& Tavernor were not standing for re-election. Cllr Garrod proposed a vote of

- c. The Asset Register was reviewed & approved, with modifications to the Insurance provisions to be effected
- d. The Risk Register was reviewed & approved
- e. The Internal Adit Plan & Terms were reviewed & approved
- f. Mr Andrew Conquest was appointed as Internal Auditor for 2022-23

2022/158 Planning

- **a.** No Applications had been received since the issue of the Agenda
- **b.** The following Decisions were noted:

DC/23/00640 — Land Behind Six Bells, 2 detached dwellings **REFUSED DC/23/01394** — Plot 2, Land adjacent to Mausoleum House **GRANTED**

c. There were no other Planning Matters

2022/159 Village Maintenance:

a. The Tree Officer reported that guard rails would be needed for trees on the Green, at a cost in the region of £150.00; Cllr Sparkes reported a dangerously precarious tree following high winds, in Bury Road - **ACTION** Cllr Sparkes to have a quiet word with the landowner

b. 1 of the 3 benches had been cleaned so far; there was no update on the Playing Field Cutting arrangements; other grass had not been cut in accordance with agreed specifications – **ACTION** the Clerk was instructed to contact the contractor

2022/160 Conservation Area:

- a. The Conservation Officer had nothing to Report
- **b.** Nothing was reported

2022/161 Footpaths:

- **a.** The Tree Officer reported that the paths were all reasonably passable owing to the lower recent rainfall; a parishioner had confirmed plans for continued maintenance of vegetation in fields adjacent to the Footpaths
- **b.** The new way marker posts had arrived
- **2022/162** Correspondence A House Swap Request was considered, with no objections raised
- **2022/163** Local Housing Needs Survey Cllr Simpson had not yet contacted the new Officer: since he is no longer eligible to stand as a Parish Councillor in Felsham the New Council will appoint someone to assume his responsibility in this area
- **2022/164 Village Sign –** The brick with flint infill design for the base was **AGREED. ACTION –** Cllr Simpson will draft a Planning Application
- 2022/165 Matters to be brought to the attention of the Council Cllr Sparkes: reported an accumulation of rubbish at a Council owned property in Bury Road; Cllr Simpson: the VAS equipment requires a new 'home' ACTION Cllrs Simpson & Tavernor to contact prospective parishioners; Clerk: Invitations to the Annual Parish Meeting had been sent: ACTION Cllr Tavernor will arrange articles & notice for F & G Village News & facebook; Clerk: The usual Co-option process will not apply after the election
